Catch up Premium 2021-22

FINAL

The government announced £1 billion of funding to support children and young people to catch up lost time after school closure. This is especially important for the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds.

Mainstream schools have received £80 for each pupil in from reception to year 11 inclusive. Schools received funding in 3 tranches:

Autumn 2020 – this was based on the latest available data on pupils in mainstream schools.

Spring 2021 – based on updated pupil and place data. This payment also took into account the initial part payment made in Autumn 2020 so that schools received a total of £46.67 per pupil.

Summer 2021 term - a further £33.33 per pupil.

We will use this funding for specific activities to support our pupils to catch up for lost teaching over the previous months, in line with the curriculum expectations for the Summer term and next academic year 2021/22.
